What is an Accountable Care Organization?

Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs) are networks or teams of health care providers (such as clinics, hospitals, doctors, and specialists) that partner with us to make health care more efficient and improve the member experience. The network may be smaller than our other open access networks, but the benefits are bigger and better.



ACOs deliver results

- Costs up to 20% cost savings compared to open access products
- Clinical quality better member engagement and care coordination
- Care higher rates of satisfaction with care that focuses on quality and prevention resulting in healthier habits and better health

ACO members also experience reduced number of emergency room visits, fewer hospital readmissions, and greater use of affordable drug options.




Travel Program Network

When traveling outside of the Medica service area (Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and western Wisconsin), members are covered by the Travel Program Network, one of the country's largest travel networks. If members have children attending college outside the service area, they can use this network, too. Emergency care services for students seeking care outside the ACO service area but within Medica's service area will be covered at the in-network benefit level. For other health care services, they will need to access care from an ACO network provider for in-network benefits to apply.

ACO service area

Most members have the option to choose an ACO. We offer seven ACOs across the primary service area of Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and western Wisconsin. ACOs deliver convenient, high-quality health care at a lower cost to members. The unique network of providers through an ACO work together to deliver a new level of complete care, coverage, and support close to home or work.







Medica CompleteHealth[™] (featuring care at Mayo Clinic)


