When traveling outside of the Medica service area (Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and western Wisconsin), members are covered by the Travel Program Network, one of the country's largest travel networks. If members have children attending college outside the service area, they can use this network, too. Emergency care services for students seeking care outside the ACO service area but within Medica's service area will be covered at the in-network benefit level. For other health care services, they will need to access care from an ACO network provider for in-network benefits to apply.
