Our Travel Program Network makes it easy to use your health plan benefits when you're outside of our service area (Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and western Wisconsin). The Travel Program Network is included at no charge for fully insured and self-insured plans.

Travel Program Network

If you need care while you're outside of our service area, you can get in-network benefits with the UnitedHealthcare Options PPO network. This is great news if you travel for business or have children attending college outside of our service area. Just look for the UnitedHealthcare logo on your Medica ID card.

Things to remember

- The Travel Program Network helps you with any urgent, chronic, or emergency care needs. But you should try to see your primary care provider within the Medica service area.
